AWARD ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. Applicant must be a graduate of a high school within Montgomery County and an active member of the Abington Ambler Alumni Chapter's Guide Right Program.
- 2. Applicant must have been accepted by a four year accredited college/university or trade school.
- 3. Applicant must have completed 20 hours of community service.
- 4. Applicant must write a 500 word essay on "What does leadership mean to you?"
- 5. Applicant must submit a 3 X 3 photo of them self.
- 6. Applicant must have a grade point average of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale.

METHOD OF SELECTING AWARDEES:

- 1. The applications will be forwarded to the chairman of the Scholarship Committee, to be received not later than the published deadline date.
- 2. A personal interview of finalists will be conducted by the Scholarship Committee. Finalists will be notified by telephone for the date, time, and location of the interview.
- 3. Scholarship winners and their high schools will be notified by letter.
